AGENCY UPDATES

At White Rock Center of Hope, the Food Pantry continues to be the most in demand service requested by neighbors in need. This year, because of your generous support, Hope is feeding more people with more pounds of food than ever before.

Withyourhelp, Hope

- Provides a drive through distribution on the first and third Saturdays that serves an average of 700 people and is powered by volunteers from local congregations and service clubs
- Distributes an average of 60,045 pounds of food each month (compared to 36,833 last year and to 32,100 two years ago)
- Connects our food insecure neighbors to additional resources, including assistance in securing SNAP/Food Stamps, additional basic needs and empowerment services at Hope, and referrals to community partners.


